GENERAL BUSINESS

- 1. Consider a Resolution requesting the Mississippi Legislature to authorize the City of Pearl to hold an election for the purpose of implementing a one (1%) percent tax of the gross proceeds of the restaurant operating within the City of Pearl, known as the Pearl Restaurant Tax District for the purpose of promoting tourism to include regionally promoting the City of Pearl for related purposes.
- 2. Consider a Resolution requesting the Mississippi Legislature to authorize the City of Pearl to hold an election for the purpose of implementing a three (3%) percent tax of the gross proceeds of hotels and motels operating within the City of Pearl, for the enhancing the

parks and recreations programs and for promoting tourism to include regionally promoting the City of Pearl and for related purposes.

- 3. Consider a Resolution requesting the Mississippi Legislature to authorize the City of Pearl to impose a special sales tax of not more than one (1%) percent for the purpose of improving infrastructure in the City, to include the overlay and resurfacing of city streets and for related purposes.
