Total for said municipal purposes 27.50 mills with 10.65 mills allocated to the General Fund and 16.85 mills allocated to City Debt.
2. Consider Order to Adopt a Resolution Fixing the Ad Valorem Tax Levy on Real and Personal Property Taxes for the Pearl Public School District for the Fiscal Year 2020 – 2021. Total for said school district purposes 58.70 mills with 51.00 mills allocated to the School Maintenance Fund and 7.70 mills allocated to 2016 Special Obligation School Bond.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF  
PEARL, MISSISSIPPI:**

SECTION 1: That for the Fiscal Year 2020-2021, there shall be and there is hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal, within the Pearl Public School District for ad valorem taxes for the City of Pearl, Mississippi, for school purposes such levies having been ordered by the Board of Trustees of said school district by order entered on its minutes and be collected on each dollar assessed value as shown upon the Real and Personal Ad Valorem Assessment rolls for the said Pearl Public School District, to-wit:

FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT MAINTENANCE FUND LEVIED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 37-57-105 (1), MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, FIFTY ONE AND NO/100 (51.00) MILLS.

FOR 2016 SPECIAL OBLIGATION SCHOOL BOND ISSUES LEVIED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 37-59-23 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, SEVEN AND 70/100 (7.70) MILLS.

TOTAL FOR SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT PURPOSES – FIFTY EIGHT AND 70/100 (58.70) MILLS.

SECTION 2: That, for cause, this resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.

**RESOLUTION FIXING THE AD VALOREM TAX LEVY ON REAL AND PERSONAL  
PROPERTY FOR TAXES FOR THE CITY OF PEARL FOR THE  
FICAL YEAR 2020-2021**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF  
PEARL, MISSISSIPPI:**

SECTION 1: That for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2020 there shall be and there is hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of Pearl, Mississippi, for ad valorem taxes municipal purposes as indicated, the following levies to be collected upon each dollar of assessed value as shown upon the Real and Personal Ad Valorem Assessment rolls of the City of Pearl, Mississippi, as to such property within the city Limits, to-wit:

FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES LEVIED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF  
SECTION 27-39-307 AND 21-33-45, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,  
TEN AND 65/100 (10.65) MILLS.

FOR DEBT SERVICE PURPOSES LEVIED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF  
SECTION 27-39-309, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972  
SIXTEEN AND 85/100 (16.85) MILLS.

TOTAL FOR SAID MUNICIPAL PURPOSES – TWENTY-SEVEN AND 50/100 (27.50)  
MILLS.

SECTION 2: That, for cause, this resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.
